Combat Volunteer

Members of your own neighborhood committed to assist the fire district make your community a safer and better place to live. Combat Volunteers are required to participate in an intense 150-hour recruit academy (weekends) and then weekly training sessions (Tuesday evenings and some Saturdays) in order to provide back-up and supplemental emergency response capacity to career firefighters in six of the fire district's communities: Clackamas, Holcomb/Outlook, Redland, Beavercreek, Springwater/Logan, and Clarkes/Highland.

Resident Volunteer

Generally these are students and/or aspiring career firefighters. These Combat Volunteers work 24-hour shifts at two rural fire stations, providing first response to a local area and supplementing response in other areas of the fire district. Resident Volunteer Firefighters are required to be certified as NFPA Firefighter I upon entry into the program and gain certification as an EMT Basic & NFPA pumper operator in their first year with the fire district.
