

EXAMPLE

City of West Linn AED post-use instructions

These instructions are to be followed after the AED has been disconnected from the patient and the patient care is no longer being rendered on scene. The AED should be returned to service as soon as possible.

1. Discard any of the following that have been used: electrode pads, gloves, razor, towlettes
2. If necessary, clean machine and/or case by gently wiping with a damp cloth.
3. Wash your hands thoroughly.
4. If you feel that you may have been exposed to an infectious disease via patient contact, notify the responding TVF&R crew before they depart the scene so they can initiate exposure procedures.
5. Request replacement electrode pads from AED coordinator in appropriate department
6. Request replacement ancillary items as needed from AED coordinator in appropriate department
- 7A. **Police Department** deliver data card, still in its tray, to Sgt. Neal Glaske or designated alternate. Insert empty card tray (in carrying case) in card slot to protect it. ***The machine does not need a card to operate.*** Card will be routed to TVF&R via Jeff Rubin in East Division. Card will be returned after data has been harvested.
- 7B. **Other West Linn departments**: contact Jeff Rubin, TVF&R East Division, to arrange card pickup: 723-6754, jeff.rubin@tvfr.com. Insert empty card tray (in carrying case) in card slot to protect it. ***The machine does not need a card to operate.*** Card will be returned after data has been harvested.
