AED Process Guide

Please use the following checklist to aid your course of action for the implementation of your AED device(s).

- Review State Statutes regarding AED use and liability.
- Complete and sign AED Request Form.
- Establish Policy & Procedure Guidelines for your facility(s). **(See policy example)**
- Establish a Maintenance plan. **(See AED Maintenance Log example)**
- Create a Deployment plan for this and future AED devices.
- Train personnel in AED use.

Obtain initial AED training from an Oregon State Health Division approved course. The following is a list of currently approved courses:

- C. [EMP Medic First Aid AED](#) (800) 800-7099

Most of these courses last less than 4 hours and include CPR as part of the course. Prices differ depending on which course you choose and whether it is taught on-site. Clackamas County Fire District 1 provides CPR and AED training. For more information, call their Training Division at 503-742-2680.
